Award of Scholarships and Freeships Policy

The college informs the students about various scholarships by displaying the details on notice board/WhatsApp messages. The following measures are taken to provide scholarship to deserving students.

1. Students are informed to avail scholarships.
2. Institute helps the needy students to avail scholarship based on various criteria.
3. A student procedure is followed to reach upto such needy students.
4. Needy students submit their application to the scholarship cell.
5. The scholarship cell in charge scrutinizer the application and the same in forwarded to need in-charge.
6. Such recommended application and further forwarded in the principal of the institution for his final decision. This guideline is ensuring of each level.

State Govt. Scholarship Yojna:

1. **Mukhyamantri Jankalyan Yojna (Sambal Yojna):** Students whose parents are registered as un-organized worker in labour Deptt. Of Govt. of M.P.
2. **Mukhyamantri Medhavi Vidhyarthi Yojna (MMVY):** For meritorious students of class XII.
3. **Gaon Ki Beti Yojna:** Rs. 5000/- per annum, every girl student who have passed Higher Secondary Exam from the Rural area school. This will be given for 3 years to those students who a mandatory appears in 1st year college admission renewal in 2nd and 3rd year on submission of application.
4. **Pratibha Kiran Yojna:** (5000/- per annum to girl students) 1st division in class 12th in BPL category, passed from school from urban area. This will be given for 3 years to those students who a mandatory appears in 1st year college admission renewal in 2nd and 3rd year on submission of application.
5. **Post Metric scholarship** for SC/ST/OBC students.
6. **Awaz Sahayata Yojna (for SC/ST/ students)** by Adim Jati Kalyan Vibhag.

Central Govt. Scholarship:
