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Differently Abled Persons Policy

Following the old tradition of our country with regards to disabled, the institution has set up plan and executed certain policies with differently abled students enrolled in any program of the institution.

These policies draw from Article 41 of the Indian Constitution and the various Acts that the country has passed over the years on disabilities such as the persons with disabilities (equal opportunities, protection of rights and full participation) act, 1995 and the rights of persons with disabilities act, 2016.

The policies are efforts, measures and activities that the institution could adopt to ensure the welfare of differently disabled.

Main Aspects of the policy areas under:-

Disability is a substantial degree of physical impairment caused due to loss of sight, hearing and speech or any other factor which prevents an individual from functioning independently. United Nations Convention defines disability as "A long term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which in an interaction with various barriers may hinder a person's full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others". Such a person must possess mandatory disability certificate and unique disability Identity Card issued by relevant competent authorities.

The institution strives to ensure the following measures for the welfare of such students:

1. Accessibility and affordability of services, facilities and resources that the college makes available to its stakeholders.
2. Empowerment concerning students with disability can be understood as the efforts and initiatives of the college as an educational institution to provide them with the necessary assistive gadgets and facilities that enable them to study and complete their education to the best of their ability.
3. Equity: It is defined as making available all required facilities to a student with disabilities at par with other students.

Our college ensures following practices to be observed for the welfare of students with disability:

1. Make all its programmes and courses available to students with disabilities.
2. Ensuring disabled students have free access to the facilities and resources of the college and to provide quality education and training at the college.
3. Install and introduce relevant state-of-the-art assistive tools and gadgets to these students to make access to classrooms, library and other facilities.
4. Prevent and prohibit any form of discrimination or harassment of such students.
5. Work towards health and positive integration.
6. In case these students fail to obtain a disability certificate, appointed cancellers, staff, etc. are tasked with assisting them to get the same from appropriate authorities.

All members of the college are aware of these policies and treat these students in accordance with the provisions.
