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## Research Ethics Policy

For the institution, Research Ethics are the set of ethical guidelines as to how a scientific research should be conducted and disseminated. It has prescribed the standard and guidelines for conducting the scientific research in a responsible manner.

### Objectives:

1. To guard/protect dignity, rights and welfare of the human participants.
2. To ensure that the research is directed in guided way without creating any hazard to the society.
3. To inspect any research event/scheme for their ethical reliability and controlling issue.
4. To inspire, guide and co-ordinate the initiatives of faculty and students towards doctoral and post-doctoral research.
5. To help and promote in identifying the emerging thrust area and research topics of academic and socially relevant significance.
6. To provide the procedure for doing minor / major research projects, knowledge of funding agencies/fellowships thereof.
7. To facilities into departmental and interdisciplinary research projects.
8. To initiates provision of institution level research awards.
9. To guide for writing quality research paper and review articles and to promote the publication of research articles.
10. To aware about rules procedure and guidelines for granting research supper, aware, funding etc.
11. To ensure quality integrity and ethics in the research work.
12. To organize various webinars etc. to develop research skills among students and the faculty members

### General Principles of Research Ethics:

1. **Honesty:** Being honest with the methodology of the research its finding/results and also with the beneficiaries and stakeholders.
2. **Integrity:** Ensuring loyalty, sincerity and dedication towards the assigned project.
3. **Objectivity:** To be fair and honest in experimental design, data analysis and other important aspects of research.
4. **Carefulness in mandatory.**
5. **Informed Consent:** It is related to the autonomous right of the individual participating in the research.

6. **Beneficence:** It is an ethical obligation to maximize possible benefits and to minimize possible harms to the respondents.

### **Different steps of Research:**

1. Collect the facts and discuss with concerned person frankly.
2. Online the ethical matters.
3. Detect the effected parties.
4. Ascertain the forfeits.
5. Recognize the responsibilities.
6. Contemplate your personality and fairness.
7. Maintain privacy and confidentiality.
