# Title of the Workshop: One Day Workshop on "Intent of Intellectual Property Rights"


Further Dr. Anjli Pandya explained the title of the workshop as follows:

#### The intent of Intellectual Property (IP) rights is to:

- 1. Protect creators' rights: Safeguard innovators' and creators' original work and ideas.
- 2. Encourage innovation: Foster creativity, research, and development by ensuring creators benefit from their work.
- 3. Promote knowledge sharing: Allow for the dissemination of knowledge and ideas while protecting the creator's interests.
- 4. Prevent unauthorized use: Prevent others from using, reproducing, or distributing IP without permission.
- 5. Facilitate commercialization: Enable creators to commercialize their IP, generating revenue and stimulating economic growth.
- 6. Balance individual and public interests: Strike a balance between individual creators' rights and the public's interest in accessing knowledge and innovation.

#### IP Rights aim to:

- 1. Reward creativity: Recognize and reward innovative and creative efforts.
- 2. Stimulate competition: Encourage competition by ensuring that others cannot simply copy or steal IP.
- 3. Drive economic growth: Contribute to economic growth by enabling innovation, entrepreneurship, and job creation.
- 4. Protect consumer interests: Ensure that consumers have access to genuine, high-quality products and services.







#### By achieving these goals, IP Rights play a vital role in:

- 1. Advancing Science and Technology.
- 2. Promoting Artistic and Cultural Expression
- 3. Supporting Entrepreneurship and Innovation
- 4. Fostering Economic Development.

In summary, the intent of IP rights is to protect creators, encourage innovation, and balance individual and public interests, ultimately driving economic growth and advancing knowledge.
