# Title of the Workshop: One Day Workshop on "Research Methodology"

#### Research Design

- Exploratory, descriptive, or explanatory research
- Quantitative, qualitative, or mixed-methods approach.

#### **Data Collection Methods**

- Surveys, questionnaires, or interviews
- Observations, case studies, or experiments
- Secondary data analysis

#### **Sampling Techniques**


- Probability sampling (random, stratified, systematic)
- Non-probability sampling (convenience, snowball, purposive)

#### **Data Analysis**

- Quantitative data: statistical analysis, hypothesis testing
- Qualitative data: thematic analysis, content analysis, coding

#### **Research Ethics**

- Informed consent, confidentiality, anonymity
- Avoiding bias, ensuring objectivity





#### Reliability and Validity

- Ensuring consistency, accuracy, and generalizability
- Pilot testing, peer review, and triangulation

#### **Key Takeaways:**

- A clear research design and methodology are crucial for conducting highquality research.
- Data collection and analysis methods should align with the research question and objectives.
- Research ethics, reliability, and validity are essential considerations in research methodology.

The speaker concluded the workshop with the statement that research methodology provides a framework for conducting rigorous and systematic research. A welldesigned methodology ensures reliable and valid results, contributing to the advancement of knowledge.
